The decision has been made to ensure the long-term viability and sustainability of the business, and most importantly to secure future jobs for our Team members.

WHEN WILL THE PARK RE-OPEN

The Wanneroo Botanic Gardens will continuously review the situation and will take steps to ensure that once the threat of COVID-19 passes, it will continue to operate.

We will work to keep our Guests and Team updated via email and social media.

TICKET HOLDERS AND/OR DEPOSITS PAID

All Tickets will be extended for the same period as the temporary closure.

For example, if the Park is closed for 3 months, your tickets will be extended for 3 months.
