Venue Hire

A venue hire fee applies for wedding ceremonies. The fee is \$780 for ceremonies held on Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays, and \$900 for Fridays and Saturdays. This fee includes use of the Gardens for wedding photographs.

The venue hire fee covers entry into the venue for the bridal party, all Guests attending, photographers, and musicians for a one and a half hour time period. It also includes a table and chair setting for signing the registry, a wedding arch, and power supplied to the selected ceremony site.

During your allocated one and a half hour booking, you will be the only wedding ceremony taking place within the park. However, a maximum of one other wedding party may be using other areas of the Gardens for photographs during this time.

We offer two unique ceremony locations, The Wedding Deck and The Waterfall Garden, providing a variety of options to create the ideal setting for your special day.

Wedding ceremonies are available to be booked Wednesday to Sunday at the set times of 10.30am, 1.30pm, and 4.30pm. Subject to approval, the Gardens may be hired exclusively on Mondays and Tuesdays outside of school or Public Holidays. Please speak with our Team for further information or to request a customised quote.



Mini Golfers

Wanneroo Botanic Gardens is a privately owned venue. While we make every effort to support wedding ceremonies, the Gardens remain open to other patrons, and we are unable to restrict access to mini golf players, casual visitors, or other guests within the venue during your wedding

As part of your wedding booking, you are welcome to invite up to 15 Guests to enjoy complimentary mini golf while you are taking photographs following your ceremony. This is a popular option for keeping Guests entertained during photo time.

Please note that all children must be supervised at all times by a parent, guardian, or responsible adult while playing mini golf.

If additional Guests wish to participate in mini golf on the day, our Team will be happy to assist with organising discounted admission where possible.

By completing the wedding application form, you acknowledge that Wanneroo Botanic Gardens is a privately owned venue operating during normal trading hours, and that mini golf and general guest activity will continue during your booking



Photos

One of the highlights of hosting your wedding ceremony at Wanneroo Botanic Gardens is the opportunity to take photographs throughout the Gardens. From manicured lawns and winding pathways to water features and seasonal plantings, the Gardens provide a variety of beautiful backdrops for your wedding photos.

You are welcome to utilise any area within the Gardens for photography. We kindly ask that you avoid locations where another wedding ceremony, photoshoot, or a game of mini golf is taking place at the time, and to remain mindful of other Guests enjoying the Gardens.

If you are interested in booking the Gardens solely for wedding photography, please refer to our Film and Photo Policy for further information.

Please note that the use of drones is not permitted within or over the park.



Booking & Payment

Wedding bookings can be made online via wanneroobotanicgardens.com.au, and payment in full is encouraged to secure advertised pricing. If paying in full, please ensure any wedding adornments are added to your cart at the time of booking to guarantee availability on the day.

Tentative bookings will be held for 14 days. During this time, a \$250 deposit and a completed wedding application form are required. If the deposit and application form are not received within the 14-day period, the date will be released. Final payment for your wedding ceremony is due 30 days prior to the date of your booking. This payment will be based on the advertised pricing at the time of your ceremony, not at the time of initial enquiry.

The appearance of our lawns and Gardens can change seasonally. You are welcome to view your ceremony location prior to paying your balance if you have not paid in full at the time of booking. During winter months, the Wedding Deck location is encouraged.

In the event of poor weather, it is the responsibility of the booking party to arrange appropriate cover or a marquee. Our Team are happy to provide recommendations and site measurements to assist with planning.

Wedding Adornments

The venue hire fee includes; the use of the table and chair setting for signing the registry, the wedding arch and power to your chosen ceremony site.

Please note: Any wedding adornments hired externally outside of Wanneroo Botanic Gardens must be arranged to be set up and taken down after the conclusion of your wedding ceremony. However, an appropriate time must be arranged with the Wanneroo Botanic Gardens Team to ensure that the set up/pack down times do not coincide with any other wedding ceremony bookings. Wanneroo Botanic Gardens is not responsible for the storing of any of these items.



Fixtures, Signs, Candles & External Catering

To protect the Gardens, we kindly request that no signs or fixtures are attached to any wall, door, post, tree, or other surfaces within the Gardens.

Tents, marquees, or umbrellas must be approved by management prior to your ceremony and may only be erected in approved locations. To assist with guiding Guests to your ceremony location, we recommend utilising ushers. Maps of the Gardens are available in the wedding brochure and can also be downloaded from our website.

For safety reasons, the use of candles with live flames is not permitted.

To minimise damage and litter across the property, outside food, drink, or alcohol is not permitted. This helps ensure the ongoing preservation of the Gardens for all to enjoy.

Music

If music is played during your wedding ceremony, please ensure the volume is kept to an appropriate level, being mindful that there may be other Guests enjoying the Gardens at the same time.

Confetti

The throwing of confetti, rice, or similar items is not permitted within the Gardens. You are, however, welcome to use real flower petals, dried leaves, dried flower petals, or bubbles as an alternative.



Garden Beds

Please do not stand in the garden beds for photographs or pick flowers from the Gardens. You are welcome to use the pathways that wind through the Gardens for bridal party photographs.

Damage & Insurance

The booking party is financially responsible for any damage caused to the property, garden beds, or equipment supplied. All wedding party members and Guests are required to observe the conditions of entry, which are available on our website.

Wanneroo Botanic Gardens accepts no responsibility for any damage to or loss of personal property before, during, or after your event. We recommend arranging your own insurance if required.



Cancellation

Refunds of monies paid, less a \$25 administration fee, will be issued upon written notice of cancellation received at least 90 days prior to the wedding date. No refund will be issued for cancellations received less than 90 days before the event.

Requests to change the date, time, or Garden location will be accommodated where possible and must be submitted in writing a minimum of 30 days prior to the wedding ceremony date.
